PURPOSE OF APPRAISAL

ARTIST PROFILE

Norman Wilkinson (1878–1971) was a distinguished British marine painter, illustrator, poster artist and inventor of dazzle camouflage used during World War I.

VALUATION METHODOLOGY

Market research was conducted using available auction databases and comparable sales. In the absence of sufficient direct market records, valuation relied on comparable works of similar period, medium, subject matter and market positioning.

MARKET ANALYSIS

Comparable artworks were reviewed and analyzed according to technique, period, provenance, artistic significance, subject matter and auction performance.

The valuation assumes the artwork is authentic, legally owned, and in condition consistent with the information supplied by the client.

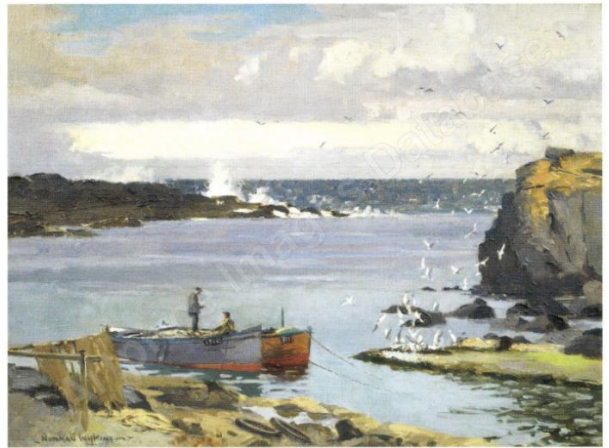
